QUEEN'S PARK UPDATE

- Gas Tax Cuts Proposed legislation that would, if passed, extend the existing gasoline and fuel tax rate cuts until December 31, 2024, which has saved Ontario households \$320 on average over the two and a half years since first introduced.
 - Ontario is investing more than \$1.8 billion in housing enabling infrastructure funding to help municipalities get shovels in the ground and build 1.5 million homes.
 - The 2024 Budget, introduced on March 26th, demonstrates how the government is continuing to deliver on its Plan to Build by investing in infrastructure to get homes built faster, attracting better jobs with bigger paycheques, keeping costs down for families and businesses and retaining a path to balance.
 - Funding for Perinatal and Specialized Services in Hamilton

 Hamilton Health Sciences will receive \$10,779,600 in
 one-time funding for 2024-25 to support the Integrated
 Pathway for Children and Youth with Extensive Needs.

BUILDING FASTER FUND

The Building Faster Fund is a three-year, \$1.2 billion program designed to encourage municipalities to address the housing supply crisis. Funding is provided to municipalities that have reached at least 80% of their provincially assigned housing target with additional funding for municipalities that exceed their target.

The Ontario government rewarded Hamilton with more than \$17.5 million for exceeding its 2023 housing target, breaking ground on a total of 4,142 new housing units last year.

Ensuring that every resident has an affordable place to call home is our government's top priority and I am hopeful that with the support of these provincial funds, there will be even more homes built in Hamilton in the year ahead.
